Dylan Hoydich placed 2nd in the Southeast at the SIPA convention—this was Mrs. Day's first student to place at this competition.

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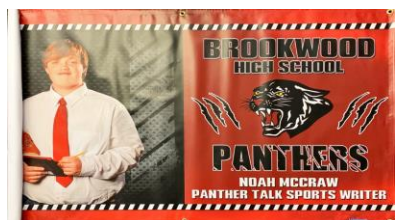
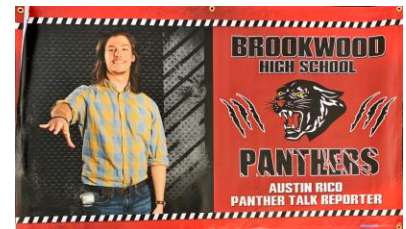
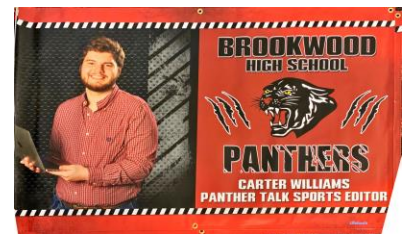
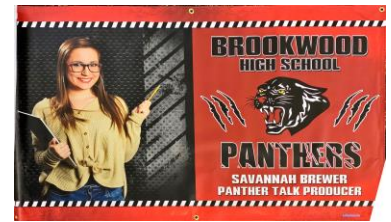
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SENIOR SPOTLIGHT—

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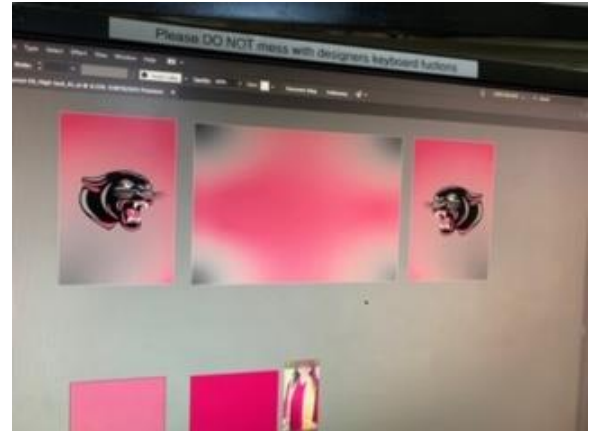
