### Coming Back to Campus?

#### **Before School:**

Students can eat breakfast or report to their designated area. *Students must remain in the same location until the first bell rings.*

#### **DESIGNATED MORNING AREAS:**

\*7th & 8th Grade = GYM

#### **Start of School:**

School starts at 7:55 am each day. Students report to Advisory first.

#### **After School:**

School ends at 3:10 pm each day.

# Basic Rules to Know:

- Students have FOUR MINUTES between each class. Use your time wisely and get to class before the bell rings.
- Backpacks are NOT ALLOWED in the classroom, except for 7th Period.
- Cell phones are only allowed before and after school. The school does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen phones. Students who violate the rules and use their phones during the school day will have their phone taken up and placed in the Main Office for PARENT PICKUP:
  - 1st Offense: Phone stays overnight
  - 2nd Offense: Phone kept for 3 school days
  - 3rd Offense: Phone kept for 5 school days
- Dress code rules apply. All clothing must meet the guidelines set by the Tuscaloosa County Board of Education:
  - Holes in clothing must be below the knee.
  - Spaghetti straps are not allowed.
  - Shorts, Skirts, Dresses must be knee-length.
  - Shoes must be worn at all times.
  - Hats or Hoods may not be worn in the building.
- All students are allowed to eat breakfast and lunch free of charge. Water fountains are not in use; please bring a bottle of water with you each day.
