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Dear Students and Parents,

We are excited about this upcoming year. This year's theme is "Squad Wars." Please go ahead and mark your calendar with the following dates:

- **Meet and Greet your Teachers** (School Supply Drop Off)- Sunday, August 5th from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- **Curriculum Night** (Come hear some great tips on how to help your child have a successful year.)
Thursday, August 30th, starting at 6:00 p.m.
- **Fall Community Forum** (TCHS Cluster Meeting) – Thursday, September 20th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Tuscaloosa County High School.
- **First Day of School**- Wednesday, August 8th.
- **Class Rolls** – Friday, August 3rd, after 4 p.m. In order for your child's name to be placed on class roll, all school fees must be paid, on-line registration completed, and immunization records updated.

First day of School – Please only plan on walking your child to class the first day. We plan on starting our regular schedule on Thursday. **Starting this year we are asking that students only bring water to drink in class. It must be in original clear water bottle.**

On-Line Registration- If you are moving please let the school office know prior to July 29th. All student's must be registered on-line before the Meet and Greet on Sunday, August 5th. We have included your child's Snap Code Letter for school registration, if you have not already submitted one. If you do not have access to a computer at home, you may use our computer lab at school. We are open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. every day. **Please bring your proof of residence to the Meet and Greet. This is required each year. (2 utility bills and a copy of your mortgage/lease).** Remember to bring in your driver's license with you each time you enter the building.

School Fees- We have also included your child's www.MySchoolFees.com Letter. You can pay for classroom donations, PTO, Extended Day, and t-shirts on-line. Print a copy of your receipt and bring it with you to the Meet and Greet.

Lunch Information- You can also put money in your child's lunch account at www.myschoolbucks.com or at the Meet and Greet.

School Hours- The tardy bell rings at 8:00 a.m. every day. Students can be dropped off no earlier than 7:30 a.m. each morning. School ends at 2:47 p.m. and your child must be picked up by 3:15 p.m. If they are not picked up by this time, they will be taken to extended day for a fee. **Our crossing guard will notify cars when they can enter the front drive of the school. Please do not pull in and block the school driveway.** We start drop off at 7:30 a.m. each morning. During student drop off and pick up please do not block any of the neighborhood driveways. After your child has received 6 unexcused tardies he/she will be assigned after school detention.

Extended Day- We offer extended services each morning starting at 6:45 a.m. until 7:30 a.m. (\$2.00 a day) Students enter through the side lunchroom door in the morning. Every afternoon we offer Extended Day from 3:15 p.m. until 5:45 p.m. (\$8.00 a day). You will pick up your child at the side lunchroom door in the afternoon.

You can register your child for Extended Day on Sunday, August 5th at the Meet and Greet. **There is a \$12.00 registration fee each year.**

Bus Riders- If you have a question about bus pick-up and drop-off times, please contact the bus shop at 342-2636. Info is also found on the www.tcss.net website. **Students are not allowed to ride a bus with another student that is not their regular bus.**

Nursing Information- All Immunization Records must be current. **Your child will not be allowed to come the first day of school and their name will not be placed on a class roll if these are not up to date.** You may drop off any daily medication or as needed medication at the Meet and Greet. Medication cannot be sent to school with your student. A parent must sign a medication form.

Summer Reading Challenge- All forms must be turned in by Wednesday, August 15th. Forms are on the school website.

School T-shirts- Limited amount of t-shirts will be available for purchase at the Meet and Greet. We have them in a variety of colors. The cost of the shirt is \$17.00 each.
