

Huntington Place State Report Card Information for 2017-2018

On December 28th the State of Alabama released scores for the State Report Card.

TCSS School System received an overall score of 77.

Huntington Place Elementary received an overall score of 83.

The 2016-2017 score was based on the results from the State Assessment, ACT Aspire. The 2017-2018 score is based on results from the State Assessment, Scantron.

Academic Achievement Overall Score: 83 (40 % of the overall score)

Reading/English Score: 82

Math Score: 85

Academic Growth Overall Score: 78 (45 % of the overall score)

Reading/English Score: 80

Math Score: 76

Chronic Absenteeism (students who are absent 15 or more days- excused/unexcused- per year) **score of 14.27/15.**

Steps for Improvement

- Teachers are receiving professional development on reading strategies to support students who have dyslexia.
- Teachers are receiving professional development on strategies to support ELL learners.
- We hired an Intervention teacher this year. She provides students with small group instruction.
- The school has purchased research-based intervention programs.
- Teachers are providing small group instruction to students to support them in acceleration and intervention.
- Teachers meet weekly to review student assessments to determine students that need acceleration and intervention.
