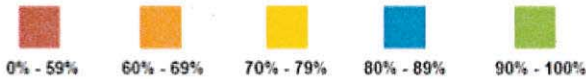

Academic Achievement - 20% of Overall Score

Determined based on the percentage of proficient students in the areas of reading and math utilizing assessments in tested grades.

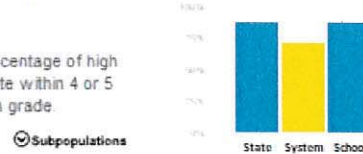
Academic Growth - 30% of Overall Score

Determined based on individual students who demonstrate improvement in reading and math from one year to the next using multiple years of data.



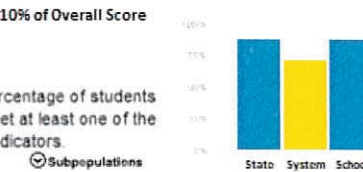
Graduation Rate - 30% of Overall Score

Determined based on the percentage of high school students who graduate within 4 or 5 years of first entering the 9th grade.



College and Career Readiness - 10% of Overall Score

Determined based on the percentage of students in the 4-year cohort who meet at least one of the college- and career-ready indicators.



Chronic Absenteeism - 10% of Overall Score

The percentage of students having 15 or more absences in a given school year. Points used in the final grade are based on the percentage of students not chronically absent.
