Information from the Brookwood High School Office

InfoSnap

Students must register for the 2022-2023 school year using InfoSnap, an online student registration system. This online process replaces all the hard copy student registration and permission forms that your child brings home on the first day of school.

You will soon receive a letter/email from the Tuscaloosa County School System with instructions on how to access the system for your student. The email will contain a link/instructions and a secure "snapcode" that links directly to your student's information.

Your student's registration will not be complete until the forms have been submitted. If you do not have access to the Internet, you can use a school computer during normal operating hours to complete the process.

Please make sure all your information, including contacts, health issues, addresses, email addresses, and all phone numbers are up to date. This year you may include your student's cell phone as a contact. You may update this information during the school year, but it must be done in person by the student's guardian.

Summer Meals Program

Breakfast and Lunch will be provided free of charge for anyone age 18 and under.
