

WESTWOOD ELEMENTARY COVID-19 INFORMATION ---APRIL 1, 2020

Student Learning Packets- Distribution begins the week of April 6, 2020

- Packets will go home weekly.
 - Bus riders- our buses will run their routes on **Monday** afternoons (following the afternoon bus route schedule) to distribute packets to students. Parents/Guardians should be at the bus stop at the same time your child would have gotten off the bus during the afternoon route. Please allow a 15 min flexible time period should the buses be off schedule.
 - Car riders and others- Packets are available for pick up at Westwood through the car rider line **Tuesdays from 10:30-11:30.**
 - If you are unavailable during these times, packets for the week will be in labeled bins at the back of the school.
- Each student in a grade level will receive the same learning packet.
- If your child receives special services, the case manager will be contacting you.
- PK will not be sending packets home at this time. OSR will share more information in the days to come.
